Submitted herewith is a report of further searches made at the Aiguille des Glaciers on 7 August 1947.

Departure: 0400 hours. Return 1800 hours.

1. Planes of searches: The upper rim of the glacier of Glaciers (North side).

The three couloirs going up to 3,730, place where the plane wrecked.

- 2. Crew making the search: Lt. MOLLARD Sgt BECK 10 guides
- 3. No remains (bodies) were found.

The searches will be carried on, on the 8 August 1947. Four crews will participate in the searches under the supervision of Sgt BOIS. They will search again the glacier de l'Estellette and the glacier of LEX BLANCHE which is at the same altitude as the wreckage place.

4. Things found: will be given to the US mission.
