 - 3. I have personally read the attached report.
- 4. I concur in the report. The aircraft is missing. The cause is unknown. All crew members were sufficiently experienced to preclude the probability that an accident occurred due to the inexperience of the aircrew personnel.
- 5. This headquarters is continuing to place emphasis on adherence to a flight plan filed prior to flight departure. Dephasis also is placed on the need for continual radio checks with ground stations, made by the radio operator, on continuous wave frequencies. Might cross country flights have been discontinued by European Air Transport Service.
